Joining Yellow Stonehouse Farm

Local community members will “share in the harvest” by paying a CSA share membership pledge fee up front to cover annual expenses. In return, members collect a share of freshly grown local produce and additional pick-your-own crops as available. Shareholders are partners with the farmer in growing food for the community.

SUSTAINABLE ORGANIC AGRICULTURE: At Yellow Stonehouse Farm, we are committed to growing food organically and in ways that care for and protect the total ecosystem: its flora and fauna, cropland, hedge rows, woods, rivers and streams. We care for all the aspects of the farm and the endangered species that live on it. Through balanced crop rotations, strict composting and cover cropping, we work to preserve and protect important land for future generations. As a USDA Certified Organic Farm, we follow Organic practices, and do not spray chemical fertilizers, herbicides, or insecticides.

PICK-UP SCHEDULE: For the Spring 2021 CSA Friday 3pm to 6:30pm on April 30th and May 28th, or Saturday 9am to 1 pm May 1st and May 29th

Shares not picked up on the selected day and for which no arrangements have been made, may be donated to local area charities or groups.

CSA GENERAL RULES

- All Shares provide a full distribution of the produce available for each week.
- Pick-ups are once a week or every other week on the day you have selected. If you cannot pick-up on your day, you can change to another day by emailing YSF one day prior to your pick-up.
- Children are always welcome but must be supervised.
- Farm is closed on Sunday & Monday including Pick Your Own.
- Pick your own Garden is closed during and immediately after any rain storm.
- You must stay out of the fields that are not designated Pick Your Own.
- All dogs must be on a leash and are not allowed in gardens.
- There are no Shareholder Membership Cancellations after April 20th, 2021.

MAY I SHARE A SHARE? Every adult in the household is considered a member of the farm. People from two households may join the farm together and take turns picking up their share of food, provided they have paid the CSA Sharing Fee. They may alternate pickups or come together in one car, but the shared CSA share must be collected at one time and divided off the farm. All shared CSA memberships are subject to YSF approval. The Sharing Fee is charged so YSF can provide more of certain single items that are not readily divided. Shared CSA shares are planned for up to five people.
