When you join Yellow Stonehouse Farm’s Harvest CSA, you receive an abundant local & certified organic farm share of produce that you select from the YSF market style vegetable distribution area. You choose exactly what you want from our plentiful supply (we’ve never run out) on Friday between 3 & 6:30 pm or Sat. 9 am - 1 pm. Your farm-share also includes seasonal access to the PYO (Pick-Your-Own) gardens growing cherry tomatoes, bush beans, cucumbers, flowers & herbs plus custom crafted recipes, spice mixes and special event menus for the holidays.



Pickups start Friday Sept. 3, 2021 and last till Feb. 12, 2022 with pickups from 3 pm - 6:30 pm on Fridays and 9 am – 1 pm on Saturdays. Pick-ups are either weekly or bi-weekly depending on share type in September and October and monthly on either Fri. or Sat., Nov. to Feb. on the following dates: Nov. 19th & 20th, Dec. 17th & 18th, Jan. 14th & 15th and Feb. 11th & 12th.

Joining Yellow Stonehouse Farm

Local community members will “share in the harvest” by paying a CSA share membership pledge fee up front to cover annual expenses. In return, members collect a share of freshly grown local produce and additional pick-your-own crops as available. Shareholders are partners with the farmer in growing food for the community.

SUSTAINABLE ORGANIC AGRICULTURE: At Yellow Stonehouse Farm, we are committed to growing food organically and in ways that care for and protect the total ecosystem: its flora and fauna, cropland, hedge rows, woods, rivers and streams. We care for all the aspects of the farm and the endangered species that live on it. Through balanced crop rotations, strict composting and cover cropping, we work to preserve and protect important land for future generations. As a USDA Certified Organic Farm, we follow Organic practices, and do not spray chemical fertilizers, herbicides, or insecticides.

PICK-UP SCHEDULE: For the Harvest CSA, members will pick-up their share of vegetables **Friday 3 to 6:30 pm or Saturday 9 am to 1 pm** Weekly during September & October & Monthly from November to February. See page 1 of this agreement for the actual dates. Please record these dates on your calendar.

Shares not picked up on the selected day and for which no arrangements have been made, may be donated to local area charities or groups.

CSA GENERAL RULES

- All Shares provide a full distribution of the produce available for that month.
- Pickups are on the designated day you selected. If you cannot pickup on your day, you can change to the other pick-up day by emailing YSF at least one day prior to your pickup.
- Children are always welcome but must be supervised.
- Farm is closed on Sunday & Monday, and the farm store may be open Wed. through Saturday.
- All dogs must be on a leash and are not allowed in gardens.
- There are no Shareholder Membership Cancellations after September 1st, 2021.
